- Age Relaxation:** SC-5 Years, ST-5 Years, OBC (Non –Creamy Layer)-3Years. For Candidates belonging to Person with Disability (PWD) category having minimum 40% disability will get 5 (five) years relaxation in addition to the relaxation applicable to SC/ST/OBC mentioned above.
- Mode of Selection:** Selection will be through a Written Test, followed by an Interview for only those candidates who qualify in the written test.
- The Cutoff date for deciding the maximum permissible age and experience (Post Qualification Experience) shall be **01.12.2016** In order to compute post qualification work experience, the period of work experience starting from the month immediately succeeding the month of final examination in which candidate acquire the essential educational qualification shall be considered. Wherever specific relevant experience is prescribed, Experience certificates/ Document issued by the employer clearly

indicating the specific area of experience should be enclosed. Academic experience like teaching, course training, research work will not be considered.

4. Candidates working in PSUs/Government/Quasi Government organizations should submit the application through proper channel or produce No Objection Certificate at the time of the interview. Such candidates, who are unable to produce NOC, will not be interviewed.

5. General Conditions:
